

L5: Performing arts; C9– creative visual arts-

Ebru

This project has been conducted in a class of pupils aged 7 and 8 years old.

The 31 pupils first became familiar with this technique from an historical point of view and discovered that they could find such marble papers on valuable book covers. The children first observed the teacher showing the method and listened to the explanations, then tried this technique which was "adapted" because of lack of material Ebru. The teacher chose to use shaving cream and acrylic paint instead.

- 1) We draw in shaving cream with the handle of a painting brush
- 2) we put a white paper on
- 3) You will carefully lift the paper up. It looks like a mess of colorful shaving cream initially. Using a plastic rule, scrape off the shaving cream. Revealed underneath will be gorgeous marble paper.
- 4) Our marble paper is beautiful.
- 5) ...make a nice bird with the marble paper for example.
