

UHTNA BASIC SCHOOL

Uhtna school is situated in North-Estonia, it is ca 100 kilometres from the capital of Estonia, Tallinn. The owner of the school is Rakvere Rural Municipality. There are 99 pupils in Uhtna school in the school year 2018/2019. We have 30 workers at school – 19 teachers and 11 other employees as a psychologist, a special education teacher, a social teacher, the canteen staff, cleaners, etc.

Our pupils come from the villages nearby, it takes them approximately from five to thirty minutes to come to school by bus, car or on foot. There are some pupils whose origin is Russian.

Our school's curriculum is in constant progress, we always take account a new learning approach, for example more integrated lessons, workshops with new solutions and implementing various ICT tools. We would like to teach students who are prepared for using new technological solutions. We have a lot of cooperation with the local youth centre, kindergarten and library.

Uhtna school is rich in old cultural traditions, we value choir singing, playing different musical instruments, crafts and different types of local arts. Our school is also innovative and active participant in different projects such as Erasmus+, eTwinning and various national projects.
