

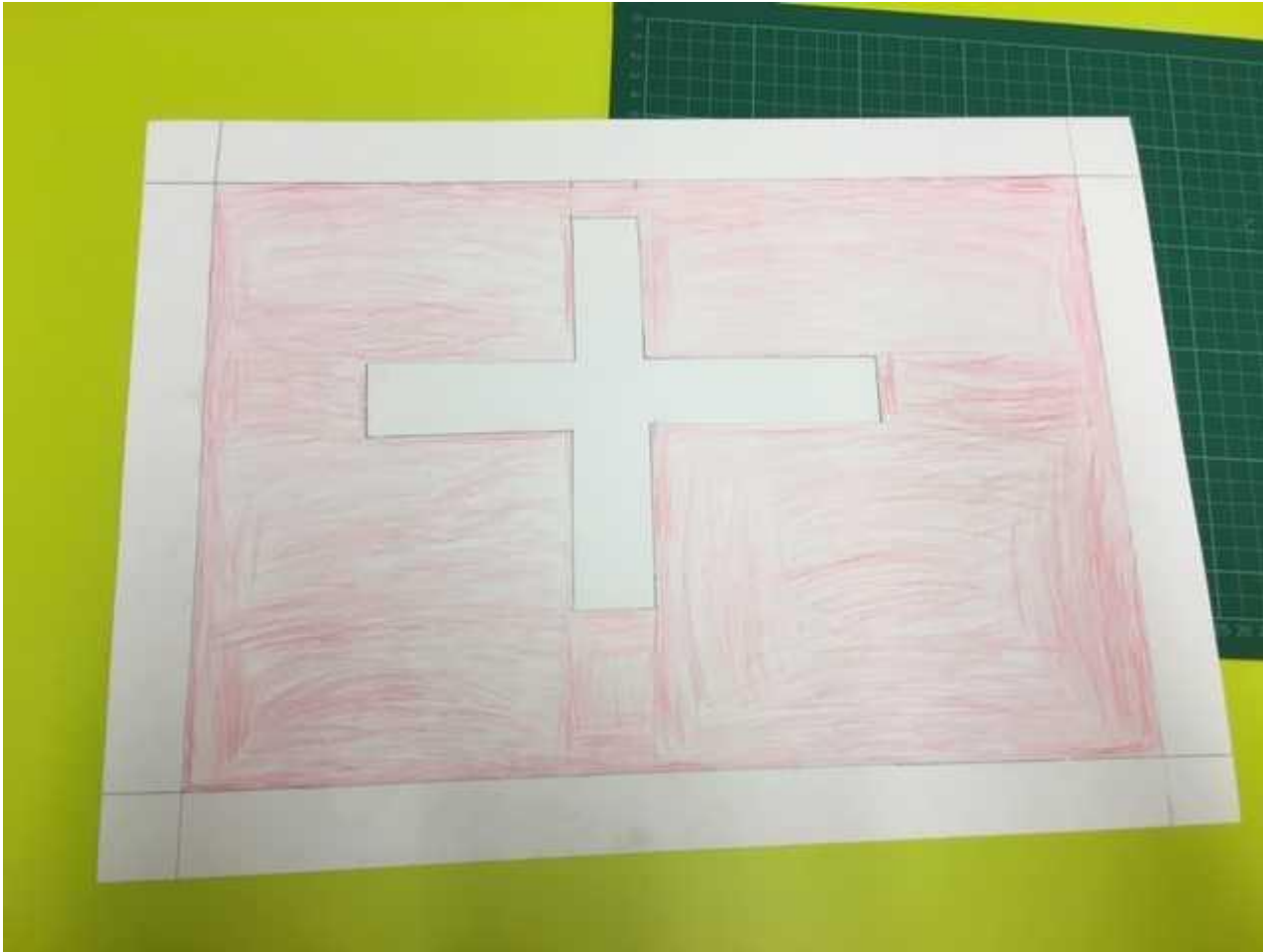


Graffiti Art – Widden Primary School

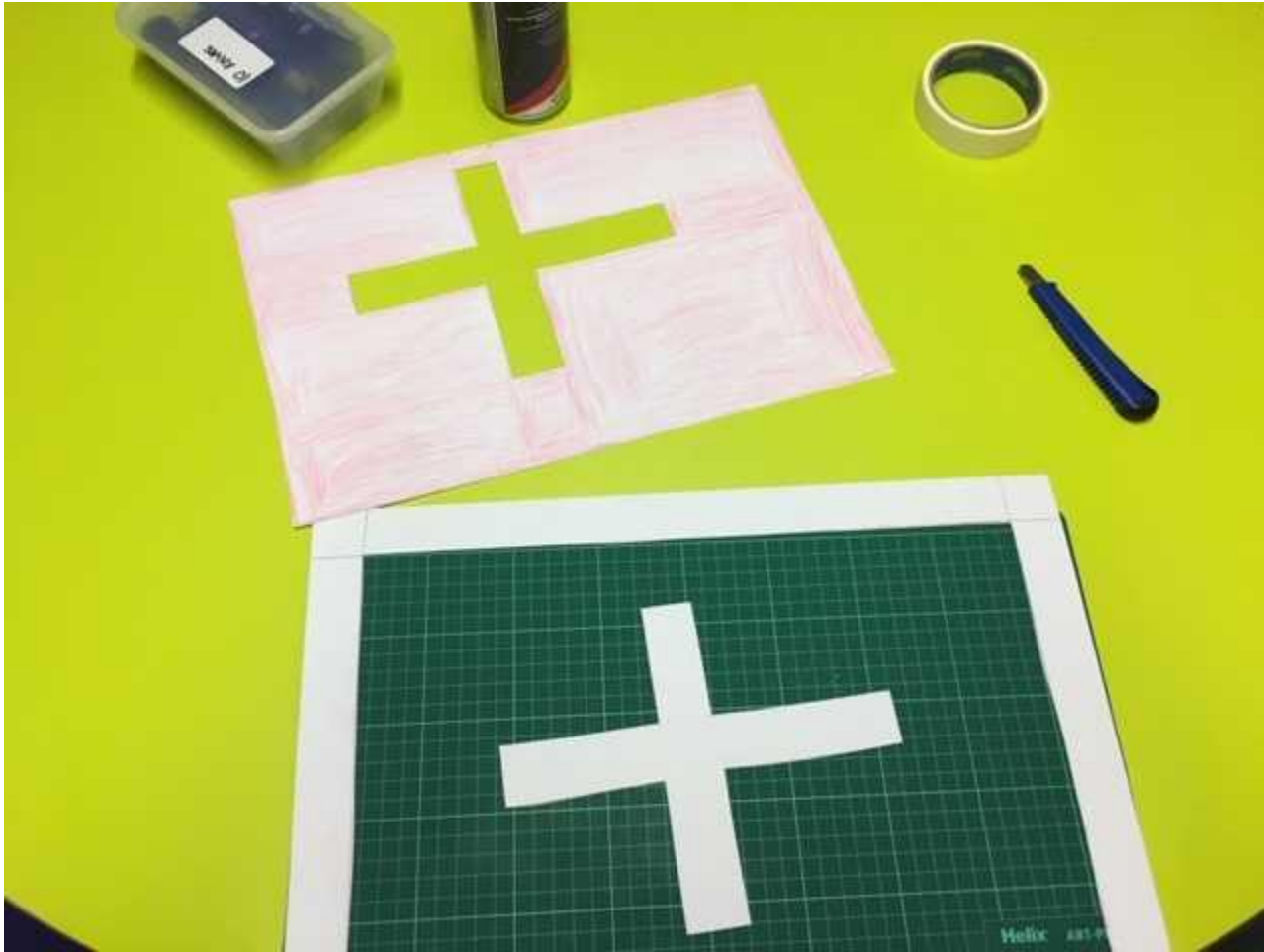


The equipment we used in our graffiti session.

Step one is to draw your flag onto the A3 piece of card.



Then, using the knife cut out the flag leaving a solid border.
This is now your stencil.



Using the Blu Tack and masking tape, fix the border to the wall.

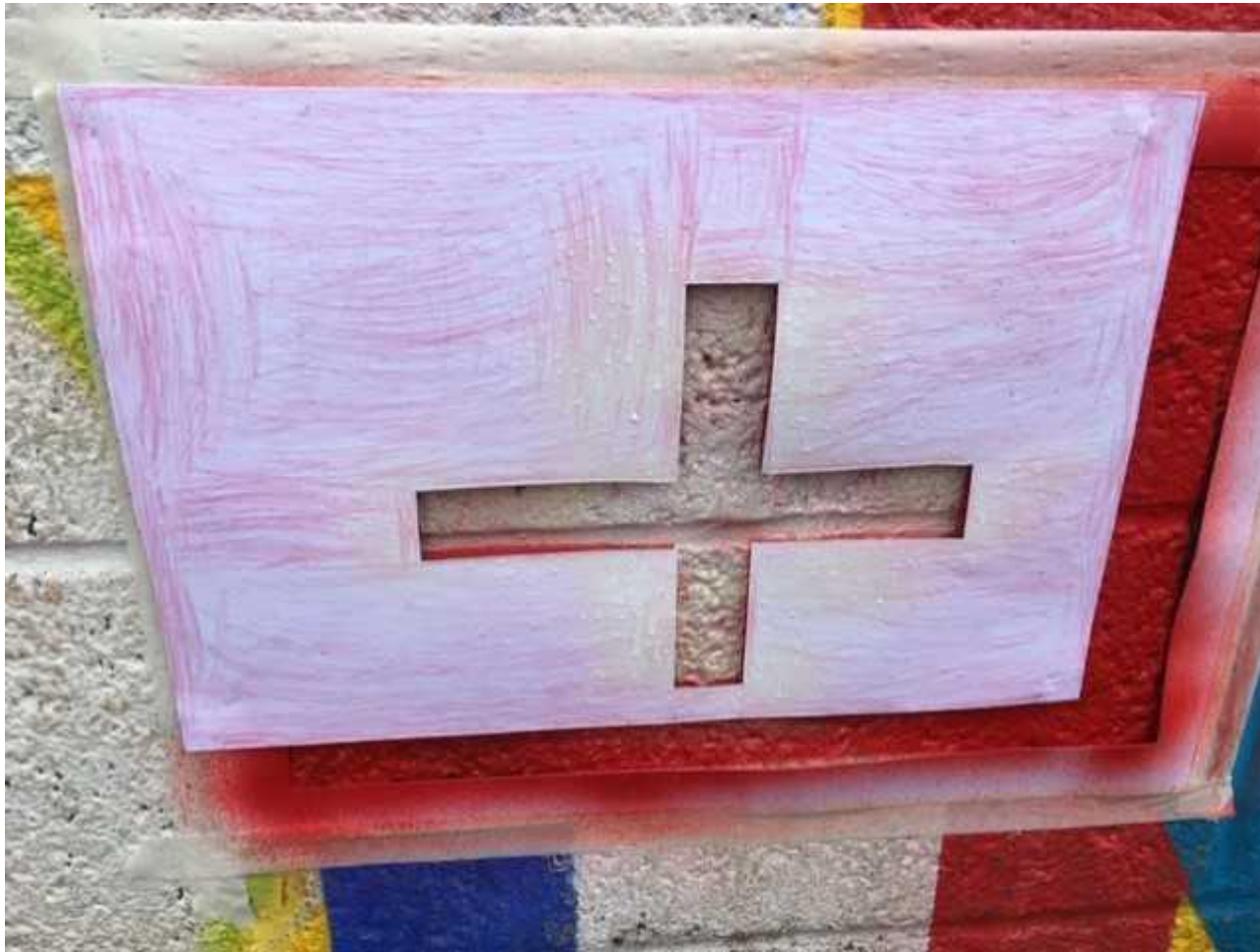




Holding the spray can 5 or 6 inches from the wall cover the area inside the border. Keep the can moving to prevent the paint running.



Wait for the first coat of paint to dry.



Spray the stencil, taking care to keep the can moving.



When the paint is dry, remove the stencil.
