

Miralba-Jesuitinas is a partially funded school in Galicia, on the northwest coast of Spain. The school is situated in the city centre with pupils ranging from 3 to 18 years old. There are 1110 pupils on roll with 50 teachers.

Miralba is a multilingual school, teaching Spanish, French, English and also Galician, the language of Galicia. Science and Arts are taught in English to Primary pupils and Maths and History/Geography are taught in English to Secondary pupils.

FUNDACION EDUCATIVA MIRALBA-JESUITINAS is a Roman Catholic School run by a team to teach pupils within the scope of Christian values.

Miralba's teachers are organised into teams, such as the Pedagogical team, ITC, European team, Artistic team and Volunteering team.

Pupils are organised into cooperative work groups using multiple intelligences and usually work on projects.

The families of pupils in Miralba are generally upper-middle class and live in the surroundings area of the school

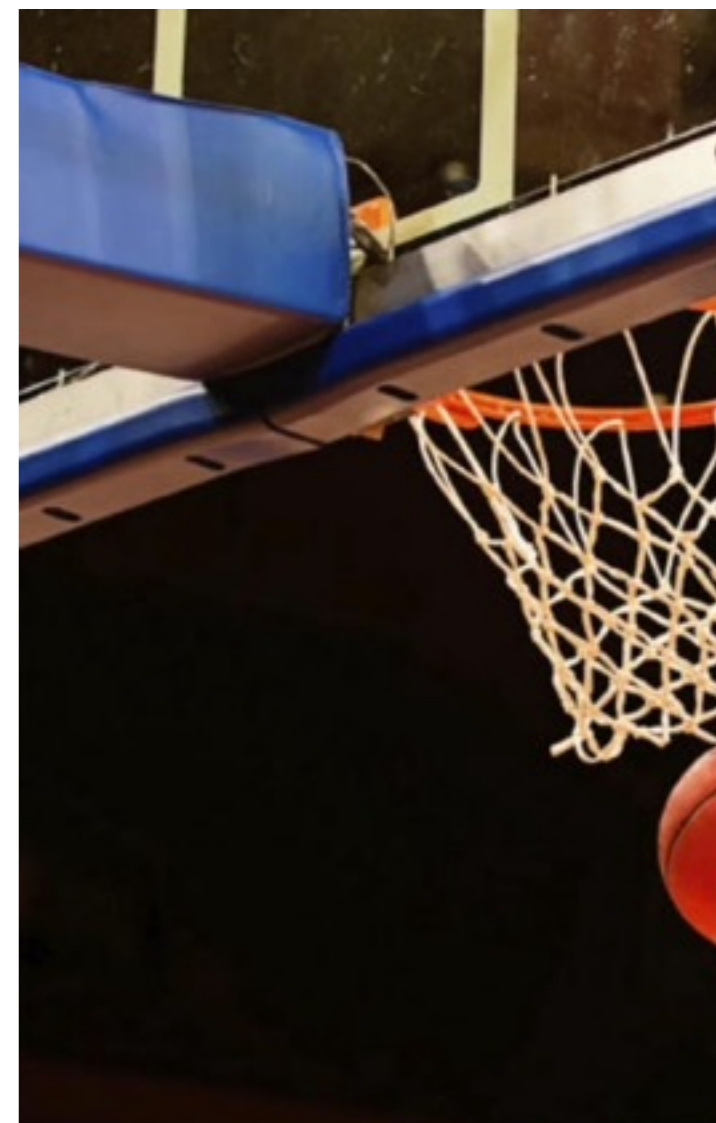
